Annexations

01

*Add territory to existing local agency (ex. water district)

*Full constituent; Typically takes 6-8 months to complete

New Governmental Entity

02

*Create a new local agency (ex. water district)

*New board/budget; Typically takes 1-2 years to complete

Extraterritorial Service Agreement

03

*Local agency can provide services outside their jurisdiction

*Not a constituent; Typically takes 1 month to complete

(Typically used to address a health & safety issue or as a precursor to annexation)
